App: Stop Motion Studio

This app is <u>free</u>. You must pay \$.99 in order to be able to upload images from your own photo library. You can get also add a "feature pack" for \$3.99, which allows you various extra capabilities.

Description of App:

Stop Motion Studio is an app that allows you to make stop motion animation either by using your camera to capture still images, or by using your own I-pad camera roll. You can add sound by recording directly onto your project, or by uploading a recording / song file from your music collection.

Stop motion studio is a good alternative to I-Movie, as it is free (as long as you use its basic features). The set-up is very simple and intuitive, so it is ideal for young students to learn the basic concepts of stop motion animation without being overwhelmed by all of the functions of a more complex program like I-movie.

Incorporation of App into Classroom:

There are many uses for stop motion film making, both in art class and within other subject areas. Stop Motion Animation teaches basic principles of sequencing, story-boarding, and understanding how moving images are created from a series of still images.

I used this app to enhance a unit on landscape drawing in the style of Vincent Van Gogh. After studying the works and understanding the drawing and painting style of this artist, students were painting / drawing landscapes with mixed media and markers.

Students created stop motion videos of their drawings undergoing the process of creation. (Think time-lapse footage of works-in-progress.) As the students were working on the projects, they occasionally came over to a photo booth that we set up in classroom to take a picture of their drawing progress. (The students helped me build the photo booth so that the I-pad could remain in one spot, and their drawings were always placed in the same position each time they were photographed.) The final stop motion animation showed a series of drawings being created – each starting as basic outline drawings, then incorporating, watercolor under washes, and finally showing the addition of Van Gogh style lines created with marker. You can see the drawings coming to life throughout the video.

Our background music was the instrumental version of Gangnam Style – a Korean Internet sensation from 2013. Our video was called "Van Gogh Style" as a parodied play on "Gangnam Style". The next step is to have students create lyrics about Van Gogh's art and life to incorporate art history into the video. These lyrics would be based on their research of primary and secondary sources.

As a final effect, students added stop motion effects to show the words "Van Gogh Style" being spelled out in time with the music.
